

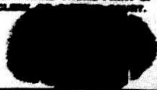

March 14, 1922
A petition from the Citizens of Orange County praying
for a district to be established by the Board of
Commissioners of said County was presented and
being duly considered it was ordered that said
petition be granted and that a district to be known
and designated as district No. 10 be and the same
is hereby established with the following boundaries to
commencing at the line between townships 21 and 22
at the point where said line intersects the eastern
boundary line of Sumpter County and running east
along said line twelve miles to the line between
townships 28 and 29 - thence south twelve miles
to the line between townships 23 and 24 - thence
west along said line twelve miles to the line between
Sumpter and Orange Counties - thence north along
said line to the place of beginning;
The Election Precinct in said District is hereby estab-
lished at the school house near the residence of
B. B. Weaver in said County of Orange

James J. Davis Attorney at Law presented
an account in favor of B. B. Bell against
the County of Orange for attendance and mileage
as returned at a high court held in said County
which was refused on the ground that no record
of said subject having been held can be found
in the Clerk's office of said County

It is ordered that the Sheriff proceed to
pay to the high court his own all the moneys in
the County Court not occupied in County offices
